Medieval Gems in a Pastoral Corner of Europe

Explore a little touch of Saxony in a charming village and at a flamboyant neo-Renaissance castle.

Meet your guide and drive into Romania's dramatic Carpathian Mountains, following a historic route that linked Transylvania to Walachia. At the Peleş Castle museum, you will visit some of its 170 rooms, adorned with lavish furnishings and intricate details. Its collection of art and artifacts is astounding and includes armor, paintings, period furniture, gold, silver and tapestries. You may also wander the gardens during your visit. Later, continue to the village of Braşov, a fascinating walled Saxon town. In the Piaţa Sfatului (Main Square), you will see the Biserica Neagră (Black Church), named for the fire damage it suffered. You will also view the Casa Sfatului with its gabled arches and clock tower. Nearby, the Hirscher Haus is one of the city's oldest buildings.

Moderate - Walking portions may be long and somewhat challenging with occasional step-ups, stairs and inclines. Total time walking or standing normally ranges from 1.5 to 3 hours.
