Stroll One of the Oldest and Most Enchanting Towns in Bulgaria

Immerse yourself in the history and architecture of Vidin and enjoy a stroll along the famed Danube River.

One of the oldest cities in Bulgaria, Vidin's rich history is displayed in the landmarks throughout the town. The Baba Vida Fortress, a 10th-century medieval fortress, was the main defensive structure during the Middle Ages and is the symbol of Vidin. You will also witness other landmarks that exhibit the city's glorious past; the "Triangle of Tolerance," which includes St. Nicholas Orthodox Church, the neo-Gothic Vidin Synagogue and the beautifully preserved Osman Pazvantoglu Mosque, is a celebration of multiple faiths living harmoniously side by side. You will also be able to enjoy some free time in the town's pedestrian zone, before returning to your ship.
