Experience Everyday Life in a Small Serbian Town

Enjoy a stroll through Donji Milanovac and gain insight into everyday life in a small Serbian town.

Set along the banks of the Danube River, the history of Donji Milanovac is an intriguing one; since its founding, the town has been relocated three times because of persistent flooding. You will explore the town's sights as you pass the lovely front yards of local houses. Pause for reflection at monuments from World War I and II and hear stories of the town's residents. You will also stop at a local elementary school and take a peek inside a classroom where you may take the opportunity to learn a little Cyrillic, an official script of Serbia. Continue to St. Nicholas Orthodox Church, a small historic church built in 1840. Admire its interior, adorned with beautiful paintings and icons, as you enjoy the local church choir's a cappella singing performance.

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Moderate - Walking portions may be long and somewhat challenging with occasional step-ups, stairs and inclines. Total time walking or standing normally ranges from 1.5 to 3 hours.
